Record of discussions of the Senior Officers' meeting held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (HFW) on 8th March, 2021 at 10.00 AM

1. A meeting of the Senior Officers was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (HFW) on 8th March, 2021 at 10.00 AM. The list of participants is annexed.

2. Secretary (HFW) welcomed all the officers and mentioned that the Central Teams have visited various States for monitoring of Vaccine distribution. The report of the said visit is required to be shared with the concerned States. However, the report has not been submitted by many officers. Secretary (HFW) directed to submit the report along with draft letters to be written to the State Governments urgently.

(Action: DGHS/ All JSs/EAs)

3. AS&FA informed that EFC meeting for continuation of schemes may be held in this month. AS&FA again emphasised that projected outlay of the schemes of Ministry for 5 years should ordinarily be not more than 5.5 times, the total scheme expenditure of FY 2019-20. Secretary (HFW) directed all officers to explain the committed liabilities of the Programmes while preparing the total projected outlay of the Programmes/Schemes and keep it upfront.

(Action: All JSs/EAs)

4. Secretary (HFW) conveyed that umbrella schemes should be reviewed at the level of Additional Secretary and adequate justification should be prepared for defending 5.5 times increase in the Projected Outlay wherever required.

(Action: All JSs/EAs)

5. As regards Grants being given to the States' Urban Bodies and

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Panchayati Raj Institutions as per recommendations of the 15th Finance Commission, AS&MD conveyed that a meeting was held on 05th March, 2021 in which representatives of MoHUA and Ministry of Rural Development were present. Secretary (HFW) directed AS&MD and JS(Policy) to prepare guidelines for release/utilisation of above funds.

(Action: JS(Policy)/AS&MD)

6. AS&FA informed that Action Taken Reports on pending C&AG para is still awaited from JS (AS), EA (NS) and JS (NV). Secretary (HFW) directed the concerned officers to expedite the Action Taken Reports without any delay.

(Action: JS (AS)/EA (NS)/JS (NV))

7. AS&FA informed that Action Taken Report (ATR) on PAC para has not been received from JS(AS), JS(GM) and EA(NS). Secretary (HFW) directed to send the ATR immediately.

(Action: JS(AS)/JS(GM)/EA(NS))

8. AS&FA further made a presentation on the expenditure and informed that as on date, 82% expenditure has been made and requested all the Programme Divisions to review their expenditure immediately and expedite expenditure. Secretary (HFW) directed all JSs/EAs to monitor the expenditure to meet the target.

(Action: AS&FA/All JSs/EAs)

9. Secretary (HFW) noted that Expenditure in Strengthening of State Drug Regulatory System and PMJAY under Centrally Sponsored Schemes is less and directed to expedite it urgently.

(Action: JS (MKB)/JS (AS))

10. AS&FA conveyed that there is very low expenditure in respect of

National Tobacco Control Programme & National Drugs De-addiction Programme, National Mental Health Programme, Assistance for Capacity Building for Trauma Centres, Health Care for the Elderly and National Prog. for Control of Blindness under Tertiary Care Schemes. He emphasized that the expenditure in respect of the above schemes has to be expedited to achieve the target.

(Action: JS(VS)/JS(VC))

11. As regards expenditure in respect of PMSSY, EA(NS) conveyed that the expenditure is on track and funds will be fully utilized as and when the same is reflected in PMFS.

(Action: EA(NS))

12. Secretary (HFW) noted that the expenditure in respect of Mass Education - Swasth Nagrik Abhiyaan under Family Welfare Schemes is low and directed to follow up with Bureau of Communication and expedite the expenditure.

(Action: JS(PS))

13. AS (H) informed that in a Departmental Assessment Board (DAB) meeting held in UPSC, the Commission expressed its concern over inordinate delay in submission of the complete proposal for holding the meeting of DAB and directed that necessary steps may be taken immediately for timely and advance action in convening Departmental Promotion Committee meeting, as per the instructions guidelines issued in this regard by the Department of Personnel & Training from time to time. Accordingly, DGHS and all JSs/EAs were requested to ensure strict compliance of the instructions issued by DoPT for timely convening DPC/Preparation of Approved Selection Panel within the prescribed time framework, as prescribed in Model Calendar for DPC, in respect of the Hospitals/Institutes/Autonomous Bodies/PSUs etc under their administrative control. This may also be monitored on regular basis by DGHS and all the JSs/EAs. Secretary(HFW) also desired that status of RRs

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(framing/amendments etc) should also be reviewed along with the DPC and should be placed as one of the agenda item in each SoM by JS(Cdn.). A format for review of DPC is annexed.

(Action: DGHS/All JSs/EAs)

14. AS(H) suggested to change the mobile caller tune for Covid Vaccine. Secretary (HFW) directed JS (PS) to look into the matter and suggest some changes.

(Action: JS (PS))

15. AS (H) informed that nowadays people gather in large numbers in various events, functions and parties and covid-19 guidelines is not being followed strictly. She suggested that there should be compulsory announcement to follow the Covid-19 guidelines during such events. Secretary (HFW) directed the concerned officers to look into the matter and prepare guidelines.

(Action: DGHS/JS (LA))

16. JS (LA) made a presentation on "*Progress of Implementation of e-Office in MoHFW*" and informed that against the target of 90% e-file implementation suggested by CVC, the Ministry has achieved 84.56%. He informed that the implementation of e-file in respect of Dte. GHS, DHR and CGHS is very poor and suggested to write to Director General, Dte. GHS; Secretary, DHR and Director (CGHS) to ensure 90% of their files as e-files in a targeted manner. Secretary (HFW) agreed to the above and also directed all officers to review their files to achieve the target.

(Action: All ASs/JSs/EAs)

17. JS (GM) informed that Home Secretary has taken a meeting on rationalisation of awards/decorations instituted by various Ministries on 5.3.2021 and informed that 17 awards are concerned to MoHFW. Preliminary information on these awards have already been sent in

September 2020. Now MHA has asked for additional inputs / observations on these awards which is yet to be furnished by many Divisions. Secretary (HFW) directed to expedite it.

(Action: All JSs/EAs)

18. JS (GM) informed about the framing and amendment of RRs of various posts and mentioned that inputs are yet to be received from various Divisions. Secretary (HFW) directed all the concerned officers to review the status and finalize RRs immediately.

(Action: DGHS/All JSs/EAs)

19. JS (MKB) informed that inputs on Compliance burden is yet to receive in respect of Dental Education Act, Indian Medical Council Act/NMC Act, Indian Nursing Council & Allied Health Act and Guidelines for Dialysis Centre. Secretary (HFW) directed to send the inputs immediately.
